

Fabric Covered Hangers with Scented Satchel

Materials needed

- 1/2 yd quilting cotton (makes 2 hangers)
- 1/2 yd lt weight fusible interfacing
- 1/8 yd of muslin
- 2 small buttons
- 1/8- 1/4 in. ribbon

Instructions (seams are 1/2 in.):

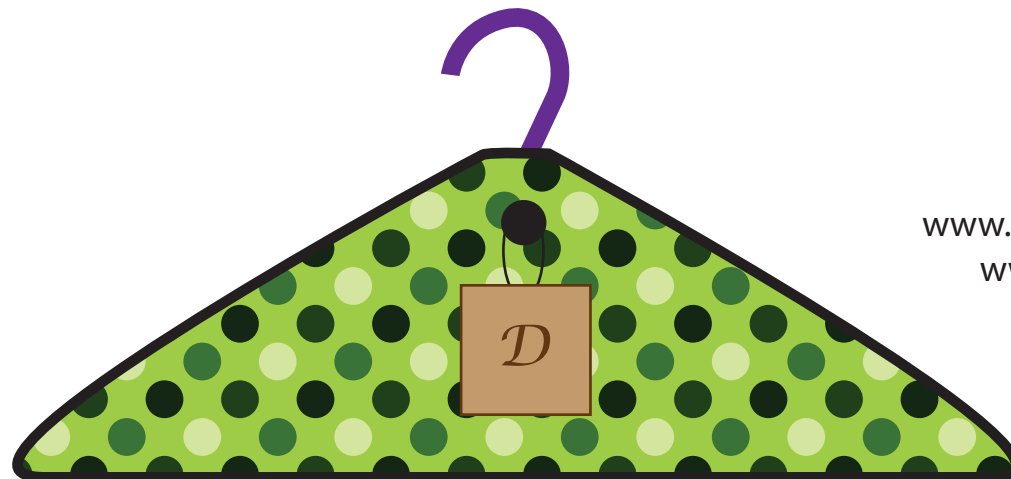
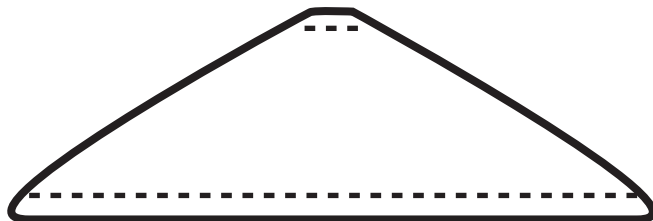
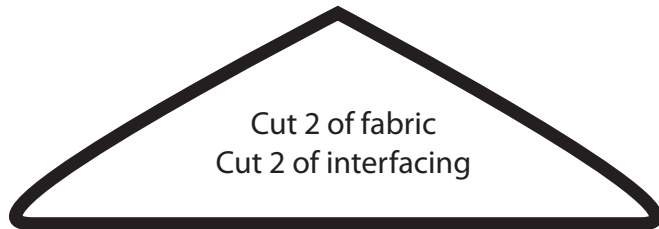
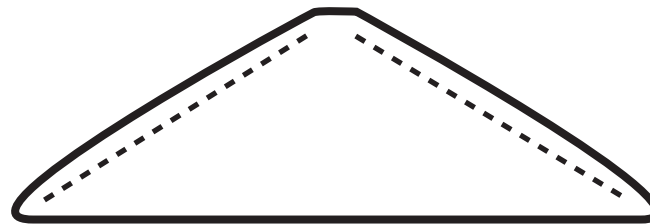
- 1) Trace your hangers, adding 1/2 in. for seam allowance on newspaper or poster board.
- 2) Cut 2 hanger pieces per fabric covered hanger.
- 3) apply fusible interfacing to wrong side of fabric pieces.
- 4) Hem the bottom of the patterns pieces with 1/2 in. hem. Hem the top hole where the hanger hook will come out with 1/2 in. hem.
- 5) With right sides facing, stitch around the sides. Start at the bottom hem and stop at the top hem, backstitching at each end. Go down the otherside.
- 6) Press seams open. Turn rightside out and press. Sew on button.]



Fabric Covered Hanger with Scented Satchel

Muslin Satchel:

- 1) Cut 2 three by three in. squares from muslin
Embroider or decorate one square on the right side.
- 2) Stitch around 3 sides of the satchel and press seams open
- 3) Turn right side out and press. Fill with fragrant herbs and blind stitch the satchel closed at the top centering a 4 in. ribbon loop to hang on fabric hanger.



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
